2017 PRINCE GEORGE'S COUNTY DOMESTIC VIOLENCE COMMUNITY GRANT AWARDS

Prince George's County, through the Department of Family Services, established the Domestic Violence Community Grants Fund in March 2017 to award grants to nonprofit organizations that serve individuals and families affected by domestic violence. Grants assist individuals, families and survivors of domestic violence in achieving a greater level of independence, strengthen the family's ability to cope with healing, and rebuild the family unit by removing various challenges which inhibit self-sufficiency. More than \$260,000 were awarded to four organizations.
