At the events conclusion, B-Roll will give a call-to-action urging community members, local leaders and members of the media to support their efforts and their students through charitable donations, sponsorships, internships and volunteering.

In addition to providing media and arts training to underserved youth ages 13 to 21, B-Roll also offers alternative education options to youth with learning disabilities or Individualized Educational Plans (IEPs) who reside in the state of Maryland. B-Roll believes that all youth deserve the opportunity to increase their knowledge, express their talents and positively impact their communities and society.
